



CRA-T 03: 4 Days Lake Manyara - Tarangire - Ngorongoro Crater National Parks

Highlights: Ngorongoro Crater & Conservation area, Tarangire & Lake Manyara National Parks, Black rhinos, Over 380 species of birds including the Kori bustard the only world heaviest bird that can fly, Tree-climbing lions, Hot springs and the rising steep escarpment of the Tanzania Great rift Valley

Activities: Game Drives, Bird Watching, Scenery, Culture, Photography, Swimming among others



Day 1: Nairobi – Arusha – L. Manyara

Transfer from Nairobi to Arusha town via Namanga border to arrive in time for **lunch**.

Late afternoon games drive to L. Manyara National Park. The park is serene and beautiful with main attractions of a rich bird life, tree-climbing lions, elephants and hippos that you can view from a close range. Lake Manyara is an alkaline lake and at certain times of the year hosts thousands of flamingos and a diversity of other bird life. Although it is one of the smallest parks, its vegetation is so diverse enabling it to host a variety of wildlife habitats.

Day 2: Ngorongoro Crater

After an early breakfast, we spend a full day within the Ngorongoro Conservation.

The Ngorongoro crater is the world's biggest whole volcanic caldera at 8300 sq km and is arguably the most stunning arena. It is frequently described as one of the wonders of the world, not only because of its geological magnificence, but also because it serves as an extraordinary natural sanctuary for some of Africa's largest populations of large mammals. Within its walls are a variety of animals

and vegetation (ranging from grasslands to swamps, forests, salt pans and a fresh water lake). You are likely to see Lion, Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, and many of the plains herbivores such as wildebeest, Thomson's gazelle, Zebra, Reedbuck, as well as thousands of flamingos wading in the shallows of Lake Magadi – the soda lake at the craters base.

Day 3: Tarangire N. Park

After enjoying an early breakfast in the African sunrise we depart for Tarangire National Park. We enjoy a morning game drive and drive back in time for lunch at our base camp. Spend the rest of the afternoon enjoying the cool swimming pool or at own leisure.

Tarangire National Park is about 2,600 sq km (1,005 sq miles) situated Southwest of Arusha.

Herds of up to 300 elephants scratch the dry Tarangire river bed for underground streams, while migratory Wildebeest, Zebra, Buffalo, Impala, Gazelle, Hartebeest and Eland crowd the shrinking lagoons. It's the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem and the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as the stately fringe-eared Oryx and peculiar long-necked Gerenuk are regularly observed. It is also home to a variety of bird species.

Lunch, dinner and overnight stay at our base lodge – Mto wa Mbu

Day 4: Mto wa Mbu - Arusha - Nairobi

After Breakfast, depart and embark on our journey back to Nairobi. ETA in Nairobi: 1800hrs local time.
